

3. Mail Delivery and Processing

As a service to you, Key will make arrangements with the Post Office to open a P.O. Box in your company's name. Key maintains a close partnership with designated Post Office locations to ensure that the highest percentage of mail available for pick-up is optimized each day.

3.1 Mail Pick-Up Times

Mail is retrieved from the U.S. Post Office multiple times per day and is delivered to our respective lockbox operations centers. We retrieve mail per the following schedule at our proprietary lockbox locations (all times are local)

3.2 KeyNavigator Intraday Summary Reporting (Deposit Summary + Float)

Key offers deposit and balance reporting, as well as detailed transaction information by lockbox, via our online reporting system, KeyNavigator. We also offer a direct data and / or image transmission with this information.

Through the Receivables module of KeyNavigator, our 24-hour internet-based delivery channel, you can easily access and retrieve check and document images, as well as various data and reports. Images and data in KeyNavigator will be archived for up to seven (7) years.

Access to remittance items through KeyNavigator will be available the same day items are deposited. KeyNavigator is also the most convenient option for you to access lockbox information, allowing you to download or print hard copies as necessary.

The standard reporting times for our lockbox locations are as follows, regardless if it is a data entry report, intraday, or transmission (all times are local):

- 8:00 a.m. Cleveland and Cincinnati
- **12:00 p.m. –** Cleveland, Cincinnati, Albany, Tacoma, Chicago, Los Angeles, Dallas, and Pittsburgh
- **3:00 p.m. –** Cleveland, Cincinnati, Albany, Denver, Tacoma, Chicago, Los Angeles, Dallas, and Pittsburgh
- End-of-Day Cleveland, Cincinnati, Albany, Denver, Tacoma, Chicago, Los Angeles, Dallas, and Pittsburgh


The following services are delivered based on your requirements:

- CDs/DVDs (Daily, Weekly, or Monthly)



4. Imaging and Reporting


Access the **Receivables** section and select **Lockbox** to view all of your lockbox activity in detail. View deposits at a glance, create a customized report and search for data and images. Hyperlinks will take you to more detailed information of deposits made into each lockbox.





4.1 Reports


The **Report** tab will provide you with a detailed view of all lockbox activity for the current day or historically for up to seven (7) years. You can use the filter buttons to change the **date** and / or **lockboxes** displayed and use the **print** button to print a version of the report, optimized for print. In addition, the **download** button will allow you to download the report in CSV or PDF formats. You can also use the **main page** button to return to the Receivables main page.





4.2 Images

Your images will be linked directly from the detail report, and you can click on the camera icons or the transaction sequence number buttons to view the images for each transaction. On the Transaction Detail screen, you can link to all the images in that transaction and view, manipulate, or print the image with the toolbar provided. You can also download all images in PDF format.







5. Additional Functionality

5.1 Search

You can easily search for images from either the Receivables basic search panel or from the fully advanced Search tab. Criteria available will be based on the originally captured set-up for your lockboxes.



You can search one, all, or any combination of the following field options using either exact or a range of criteria:

- Lockbox Number
- Batch Sequence Number
- Check Routing
- Transit Number
- Batch Amount
- Check Number

- Check Amount
- Check Serial Number
- Transaction Sequence Number
- Deposit Date
- Transaction Item

The following twelve optional search fields are also available if you choose to use Key's data entry service:



5.2 Customized Display Settings

By clicking on the **Settings** tab, you can customize your display settings. For example, choose the lockbox to view or edit as well as how the data is displayed on the screen each time you enter the system.





6. Questions and Assistance
